**1910 Craighead County Census**

The 1910 Craighead County Census will be published in two volumes. Volume I will contain the following townships: Big Creek; Black Oak; Brookland; Buffalo; Gilkerson, Greenfield; Herndon; Powell; and part of Jonesboro (not including Jonesboro City).

Volume II will include Jonesboro City; Lake City; Lester; Little Texas; Prairie; Nettleton; Promised Land; Texas; and Maumelle. The townships follow the order in which they appear on the microfilm.

Volume I will be ready for purchase by the end of April 30, 2001 and Volume II should be ready by July 1, 2001. The cost of each volume is \$30 for non-members and \$25 for members. The set may be purchased for \$50 for non-members and \$45 for members.
